11.	Grab-line (only on dive boats).										
12.	Capsize Rope (ONLY on inflatable and ski-boats < 9 m in length).										
13.	Patent anchor with chain and min 50m (v/l > 6m - 5m chain; v/l < 6m – 3m chain).										
14.	Drinking water (750ml per person)										
15.	First-Aid kit – suitable for crew and compliment.										
16.	Repair kit and air pump or bellows (inflatables).										
17.	Spares and tools.										
18.	Exhaust pipes and silencers water cooled and lagged.										
19.	Marking of Equipment Vessel and Trailer.										
20.	Navigation Lights.										
21.	Steering gear (including Emergency Steering).										
22.	Kill switches (outboard engines)										
23.	Towing line of at least 10m (engine <15hp & non-power driven Less than 7m).										
24.	Bailing device (engine < 15hp & non-power driven Less than 7m).( non self draining vessels )										
25.	500 mm square red flag (for water skiing only).
