## Slipway Rules

updated September 2020

- The club slipway is there for the sole use of members boats. Under no circumstances are members allowed to slip non-members boats on the club slipway nor permit their craft access to the club boat yard, unless it forms part of an organized event or there is prior arrangement with the club management.
- Members permitting non members to access PYC and use the PYC slipway will be billed R450 per launch of the non members boat and may receive a disciplinary notice.
- Be careful as the Slipway is Slippery when wet.
- The PYC Slipway is to be kept clear at all times other than when launching or retrieving your boat.
- Boat mooring maximum time limit of 15 Minutes is permitted on the PYC Walk-ons adjacent to the slipway.
- Do not rig your boat, load or unload gear from the boat while at the PYC Slipway.
- $\quad$ No vessel with an expired survey or safety certificate is permitted to launch from the PYC Slipway.
- All craft launching at the PYC slipway must enter their particulars in the Launch Register.
- Launching dollies during sailing may be stored on the south side of the PYC Slipway.
- Motor vehicles to be returned to the parking area once boat has been launched.
- Trailers may only be parked in the trailer parking area whilst members are using their boats for sporting and/ or recreational purposes at sea or in the habour.
- Only suitably qualified skippers are permitted to take any vessel to sea or in the habour from PYC.
- Permanent mooring is not permitted on the Walk-ons adjacent to the slipway.
- Stones or rocks may not be used as chocks on the PYC Slipway
- Boat maintenance procedures may not be carried out on the PYC Slipway.
- No washing of boats on PYC Slipway or in the turning circle at the top of the PYC Slipway.
- All litter must be thrown into the refuse bins provided.
- No bait or fish remains are to be disposed of in any bins on PYC premises.
