Dates: 02 July to 08 July 2022

Venue: Point Yacht Club

Organising Authority: L26 Class Association in conjunction with the Point Yacht Club with the consent of SA Sailing.

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules Of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The SA Sailing prescriptions for Regional Championships will apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board no later than 10h00 on 3 July 2022 and will be available at registration.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board is located at Point Yacht Club.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all Keelboat, multihulls and the L26 class.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering by 03 July 2022.
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees to Point Yacht Club.
- 4.4 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Entering online after Monday, 27 June, but before 16h00 on the 03 of July 2022.
- 4.5 All competitors shall be members in good standing of SA Sailing and of a yacht club affiliated to and in good standing with SA Sailing (or their equivalent in the case of non-South Africans) and legally permitted to compete.
- 4.6 Proof of such membership shall be presented at registration.

5 FEES

Entry fees are as follows:

*Standard entry fee
Yacht with Skipper – R850
Each Additional Crew - R200 each*

Late Fee – R1000 additional (after 27 June)

6 ADVERTISING

[DP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

7 SCHEDULE

7.1 Registration: 02 July and 03 July 2022, from 9h00 to 16h00.

7.2 Equipment inspection and event measurement: 02 July and 03 July 2022, from 09h00 to 16h00.

7.3 Dates of racing: 04 July 2022 to 08 July 2022.

7.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is: 12h55.

7.5 A maximum of 12 races are scheduled.

7.6 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 14h30.

8 MEASUREMENT

8.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

8.2 Boats shall be available for equipment inspection from 02 and 03 July, 9h00 to 16h00.

9 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

[DP] Support person vessels shall be marked with a *white flag*.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the race committee and SAS medals will be awarded to the top three finishers, provided that the requirements for a regional and national championship, respectively, have been met.

11 RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." Competitors participate in this event entirely at their own risk. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of R1 million per incident or the equivalent.
