13	Suitable Means of cutting standard rigging (I.e. Hacksaw or wire cutter)	
14	Proper Patent Anchor and chain with suitable length of rope for the area of operation	
15	Watertight Capsize bottle, attached to the vessel with rope, accessible in the event of capsizing	
16	Two Space Blankets	
17	One Litre of drinking water per person	
18	First Aid Kit suitable for the vessel's size and compliment	
19	Spares and Tools adequate for the purpose of carrying out emergency repairs to machinery and essential equipment onboard	
20	Bailing Device (Engine < 15hp & non-power driven L<7m)	
21	2 meters of canvas with Eyelets and Lanyards	
22	Stanchions and lifelines strong and secure	
23	Working functional and serviceable motor (Must go in and out of gear on moorings)	Inboard or Outboard
